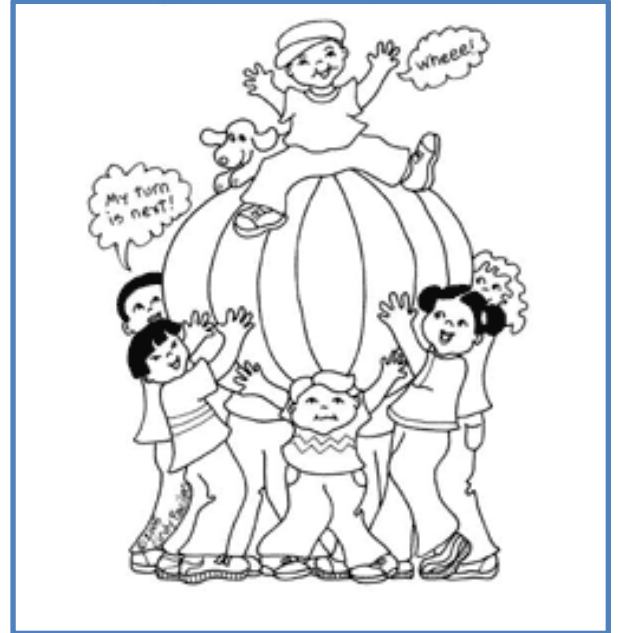

## 6. Care for our environment

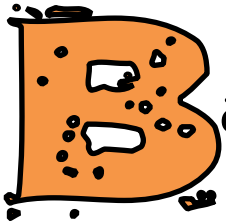
This means keeping the school yard and the classroom clean, not littering and turning off taps and lights.

It also means composting your food scraps and letting the garden grow.

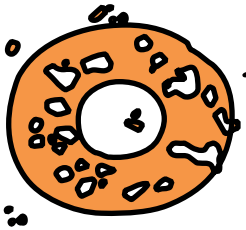


# Bounce Back

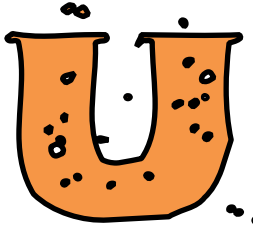
When things don't go well or you feel unhappy, you can change the way you think and feel. Remembering these 'BOUNCE' ideas can help you feel better.



Bad feelings always go away again.



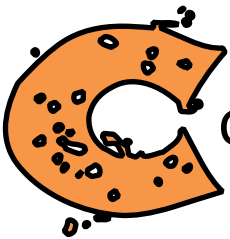
Other people can help you feel better if you talk to them.



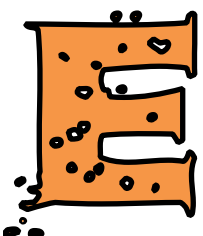
Unhelpful thinking makes you feel more upset.



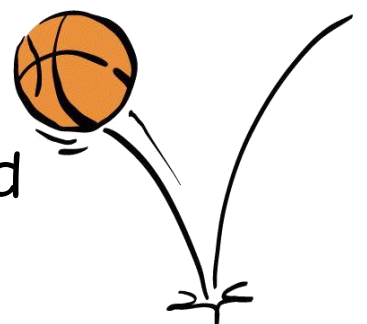
Nobody is perfect. Mistakes help you learn.



Concentrate on the good things and have a laugh.

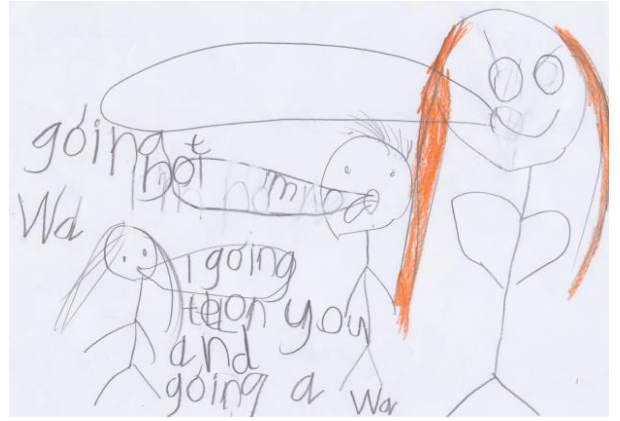


Everybody feels sad and worried sometimes, not just you.

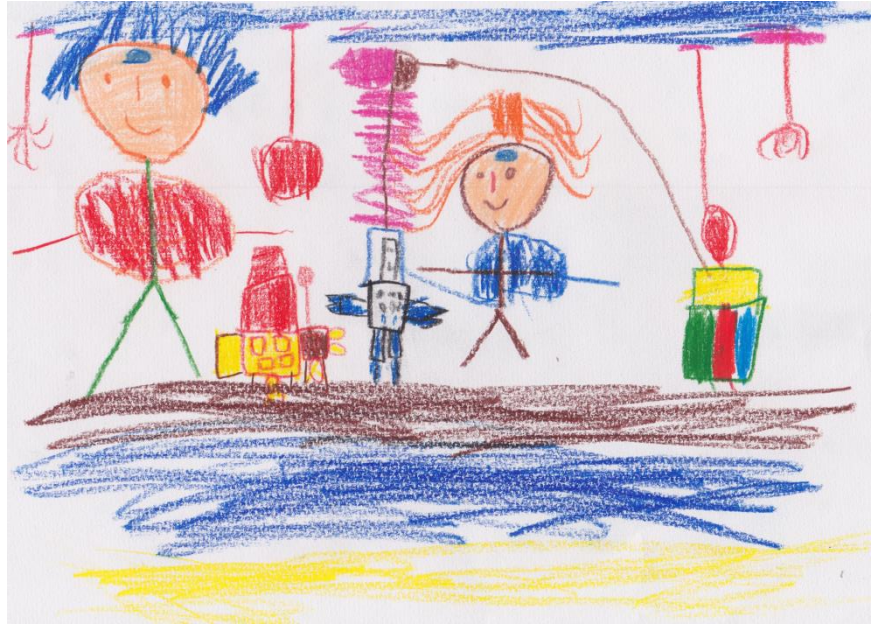
